"International Exhibition Centre 'Big Sight' "

On the Ariake Marine Transport Terminal, a completely new part of the city was created by dredging. Situated directly by the water, the funnel-shaped exhibition centre represents one of the most striking buildings in the city. In the meantime, it has already become a sight in the port of Tokyo.

The green roof was carefully consulted and designed by the company "Tajima Roofing", due to the especially exposed location and resulting extreme climatic conditions such as strong Pacific winds and salty air.

With the harsh conditions of this location, the vegetation benefits especially from the drainage element as it allows for a good compensation for the lost connection with the natural ground. Regular care and maintenance is required due to the extreme conditions of this exposed location.
