### “Rehabilitation Spa Building”

The green space in front of the physicians’ area is mirrored by the green roof and can be seen from the footpath. Similar to the green area in the front, the roof is intended to express a meadow character. A low-maintenance green roof vegetation of grass and shrubs correspond with this intention, and allows for a visual and creative integration of the roof into the surrounding environment.

Through extensive care, the green roof, which was originally planned to be mainly a lawn roof, has turned into one with a meadow character. Even the autumn aspect of the green roof provides an attractive look for the visitors.
